<sup>1</sup>This is course-level data. When multiple sections of a course were provided, the course's vote was divided among the rubrics indicated for each section.

<sup>2</sup>Course outcomes are weighted by how many courses are offered within a given prefix. So if a prefix provided data on 30 different courses then each course was counted as 1/30. If a prefix offered 5 courses, each course counted as 1/5. In essence, each "prefix" gets a single vote distributed among the courses offered by the prefix.
