## I-5 SOUTHBOUND

Take exit 260-A (Salem Parkway) and follow the parkway into Salem until you come to Commercial Street. Go left on Commercial and follow this street to Marion Street. Turn right on Marion, and as you cross the bridge, merge into the left lane. You will be on Highway 22. Continue approximately 10 miles until you reach Highway 99W. Turn left onto Highway 99W and follow signs to Monmouth.

## I-5 NORTHBOUND

Take exit 228 (Corvallis/Highway 34W). Follow Highway 34W for approximately nine miles to Corvallis. As you approach Corvallis, merge into the right lane. After crossing the bridge over the Willamette River you will take a right lane on 3rd Street/99W and follow the signs to Monmouth. Continue on 99W for approximately 20 miles until you reach Monmouth.

## PARKING

From Highway 99W, take Main Street west following the signs to Western Oregon University. At N. Monmouth Avenue, turn right (north). Turn left on Jackson Street. The Natural Sciences Building is on your right. Parking is available in Lot F for Science/Math Careers Day participants at no charge (except in the metered spots, which are enforced at all times). Lot F is on the right at the next intersection (College Street).

Western Oregon University is a four-year, public liberal arts university offering 44 bachelor's and master's degrees through its two colleges — the College of Education and the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences. WOU's picturesque campus is located in Monmouth, 20 minutes from the state capital of Salem in the heart of the Willamette Valley.
