Why WOU needs an Articulation Manual

- Establishes a defined process to facilitate coordination, tracking, implementation, and management of articulation agreements in a uniform way.
- As an institution we need a defined rationale for why we engage in articulation agreements.
- Ensures that WOU is a good partner institution.
- Transparency.



Articulation Agreement Types

- Initiated by academic or support units
 - Program-to-Program
 - Course-to Course
- Initiated by administrative units or organizations
 - Statewide agreements (HB 2998)
 - Reverse Transfer
 - Admissions Agreements (International)
 - Dual Admission (previously Dual Enrollment)
 - General Education Block Transfer (Interstate Passport)
 - Letter of Agreement (Salem-Keizer School District)



The process in a nutshell....

- Assess for alignment with the Guiding Principles.
- Discuss with your Department head, Program coordinator, Division chair, or Dean.
- Submit the online “Notice of Intent.”
- Dr. Mauro will review each request and will reach out for additional information (if needed).
- Dr. Mauro will coordinate the process
 - Engage all parties/departments impacted
 - Coordinate the signatory process
 - Archive the agreement & notify campus
 - Implementation of the agreement (if needed)
