

Riverwood Orchard is nestled between the Luckiamute and Little Luckiamute Rivers in Polk county. Here, orchard owner, Allen Frost nurtures a bounty of sweet, crunchy apples - some of which are destined to be consumed by students, faculty and staff at Western Oregon University - all part of the plan to purchase as much fresh fruit and produce locally as possible.

Allen and his wife became a part of the "Polk County scene" in 1990, when they relocated here after growing apples in Washington state for nearly a decade. Fed by ample rainfall, Riverwood grows and sells many varieties of apples including Gala (featured seasonally and fresh in Valsetz Dining Hall) Honey Crisp, and Jonagold. Riverwood apples can be purchased at both the wholesale and retail levels.
