Facilities Services is a service-oriented organization charged with the responsibility of maintenance and operations of the buildings and grounds allocated to Western Oregon University.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Three years of general building maintenance experience in one or more of the following trade areas: carpentry, electrical, mechanical, painting, plumbing, and welding.
- Valid State of Oregon Driver's License
- Ability to climb stairs, ladders and scaffolding.
- Ability to lift 50lbs.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Mechanical Repair

- Maintenance and repair of larger equipment such as HVAC and refrigeration systems
- Install and repair steam pipes, valves, fittings, grates, chimney caps, kitchen equipment, and other sheet metal articles
- Replace minor components such as batteries
- Repair small motors such as compressor, water pumps, and fans

Plumbing

- Repair or replace plumbing including pipes, drains, tubs, faucets, and other plumbing fixtures and equipment; Repair old
 plumbing such as replacing breaks and renewing washers and valves
- Clean and open drains and other water lines

Electrical

- Maintenance and repair of wiring systems and electrical fixtures and equipment
- Replace fuses, bulbs and globes
- Assist in installing electrical conductors

Miscellaneous

- Use tools and equipment of various trades such as pipe cutters, saws, drills, planes, sanders, shears, and acetylene and MIG welding equipment
- Drive truck to run errands and deliver supplies
- Perform preventative and maintenance program through scheduled inspection and servicing of equipment and facilities
- Read and work from blueprints, shop drawings and sketches to complete assigned tasks

Carpentry

- Perform general maintenance and construction work such as building fences, repairing barns and similar structures
- Install shelves; hand doors; frame walls; use power tools such as drill presses and radial arm saws

Painting

- Clean surfaces to be painted by use of scrapers and dusters
- Mix and apply paints to surfaces such as walls, beams, and girders; Mix and apply plaster

General Facilities Support

- Assist in campus moves, set-ups and special events
- Perform emergency services by the Director of Facilities Services, the Associate Director, or their designee

WORKING CONDITIONS:

Requires physical abilities to perform sustained arduous tasks under adverse weather conditions. Work in confined spaces such as vaults and tunnels and rooftops and/or elevated positions as high as 75'. Work climate is often dusty, humid, and located in either hot or cold temperatures. Some work may need to be performed while wearing a respirator. Weekend duties, holidays, and evening shifts will be assigned, as needed. This position will be on-call for emergency call backs and is part of the Facilities Services after-hours response team.
