Western Oregon University invites applications for a full-time, tenure-track, Assistant Professor position in Social Psychology or a closely related field. The successful candidate would join a robust division with 12 other tenure-track faculty and several non-tenure track faculty (please see our website at the following link: <http://www.wou.edu/behavioralsciences>). Notably, we have a diverse student population, particularly with regards to non-traditional student populations and veterans. We welcome applications from scholars who are from populations historically underrepresented in the academy, and/or who have experience working with diverse populations.

The teaching load is three courses per term and may include Social Psychology, Advanced Social Psychology, Quantitative Methods, Research Methods, Introduction to Industrial/Organizational Psychology, History of Psychology, General Psychology, and seminars/courses in the applicant's specialty area.

Qualifications:

- A Ph.D. is required. (ABDs considered if degree will be completed before the start date).
- Candidates with teaching experience, an established research program, and a strong quantitative background are preferred.
- Applicants able to develop courses in which social psychology is applied to other areas of psychology, such as cognition, development, law, emotion, or health, will be given preference.
