Department / Job Summary:

This position is in the University Computing Solutions Department at Western Oregon University in Monmouth. The Computing Services department is responsible for systems, desktop support, networking, telecommunications, web support, video support, institutional research, programming, and technical support for the institution.

A low voltage technician's position is primarily responsible at varying levels for technical system support and capabilities, including the installation, maintenance, modification, and repair of equipment, products, and/or systems. Technical systems may be electromechanical or computerized (e.g. computer and peripheral equipment, audio and video equipment, and related transmission equipment and systems) and typically are integrated with or interconnected to larger systems.

These duties include, but aren't limited to, the following:

- Install and configure audio and video Smart Classroom systems, standard operating network systems, and integrate them with related systems
- Assist in planning and implementing installations and/or facility layouts
- Perform physical installation (e.g. wiring, cables, components, and sound systems and necessary interface cards)

We are not considering candidates who require Visa sponsorship support. Additionally, the university typically only considers visa support for employees placed in specialized positions that are continuing regular university appointments.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Limited Energy Technician – Class A or B license in the State of Oregon
- Demonstrated experience installing, maintaining, and supporting audio and video systems
- Fundamental knowledge of control systems
- Ability to physically install and configure equipment, connections, wiring, and cable working from layout or plans

Preferred Qualifications:

- Experience with Crestron control systems, including programming
- Experience installing network and telephony infrastructure
