Travel Signature: If you or your dependents will be traveling outside the US during your F-1 or J-1 program (including any periods of practical or academic training), you will need to obtain a travel signature from the Office of International Education and Development prior to leaving the US.

The travel signature is valid for only 6 months.

- Your Passport
- Your U.S. Visa
- Your most recent I-20 or DS-2019 immigration document
- Your I-94 Card or Printed version from online
