

WOU RETURNING ART STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS

If you will be returning as an Art major next fall, you are eligible to apply for a partial tuition scholarship. Up to three scholarships will be awarded.

Deadline: Friday, April 10, 2009

Rules

You must be enrolled as a full-time art major next fall term to be eligible to receive the scholarship, which will be in the form of a tuition waiver credit.

Submissions

Portfolios are due between **8:00 a.m. and 12:00 noon, Friday April 10, 2009 in CH 104** Frames and mats are not required, but please present your work as cleanly and professionally as possible. Please include:

- Artist's statement, including your background and experience
- The bottom half of this form, filled out with your information
- 5 to 8 pieces of artwork or slides (no more than 8 pieces) with your name clearly marked on any pieces that will not fit in a standard portfolio (sculptures, ceramics, large paintings). You may write statements to explain the works if you wish.

Awards will be announced at the opening ceremony of the Annual Student Art Show.
