All the LiDAR data we currently have is posted for download on our new Public FTP site here:
<ftp://159.121.106.159/elevation/lidar/>

We currently have 500 GB of data posted.

It typically includes, by delivery, Shapefiles of delivery areas, GRIDs of first return (highest hit), last return (bare earth) and Imagine LiDAR intensity images.

If you don't already have an FTP client, I would suggest Filezilla, which is free and works excellent.

GPL Users,

A few notes on the FTP server and the recent postings.

1. I've received a number of emails regarding being prompted for a user/pass login.

This public site should require no login.

Apparently Internet Explorer is behaving differently for different users. I can connect via IE or Firefox without any login prompt. FTP via a web browser is not recommended.

I would recommend the following software to make the connection.

2. Also, please note that there is a huge amount of traffic on the server, since this is the first time it has been announced as open to the public. You may need to wait to make the connection. I assume this will taper off as those who want the LiDAR data finish downloading.

3. Willamette Valley Delivery 10 was not correct. I have removed it. It was a copy of delivery 1. I will get that data from DOGAMI and make it available as soon as we can get it.
