

Talmadge Middle School Dress Code (p. 12 of Talmadge Handbook).

DO NOT WEAR ANY OF THE FOLLOWING

Violations of the dress code include:

- Clothing, jewelry, belt buckles, body decorations or other items with references to drugs, alcohol, tobacco, violence, or gang affiliation. Examples include but are not limited to brick walls, 8 balls, clock faces, clown shirts, marijuana leaves, mushrooms, alcohol/cigarette brands, jokers, prison towers, hairnets, bandanas, 420, 187, 18, 13
- Clothing that compromises modesty, including tank tops, halter tops, tub tops and dresses, one shoulder tops and dresses, spaghetti straps, muscle shirts, backless tops and dresses, or tops and dresses that expose the midriff area, see through garments; exposed undergarments. All shirts, tops, and dresses must have sleeves. NO shorts allowed for mentors.
- Anything with reference to racial insults, racial pride, sexual innuendo, profanity or obscenity (i.e., Player 69 clothing)
- Anything that compromises the safety of others and self including chains, security and dog chains, spiked or studded garments, full-length coats or outer garments worn in the building, sunglasses, belts worn outside of belt loops, safety pins.
- Hats or headgear, including hoods.
- Anything that attracts undue attention or is disruptive to the learning process, including but not limited to safety pins, disruptive piercings, disruptive tattoos, disruptive hairdos, torn clothing.
- Drawing or writing on backpacks, notebooks, clothes, or assignments that compromises health, safety or the learning process. No writing or drawing of any kind on the body.
