WORKSHOP DESCRIPTIONS

Reference Points, Transition Pegs & Other In-Car Challenges

This workshop will focus on solutions to common challenges encountered during in-car driving lessons.

Utilizing Technology – Beginners (computer lab space is limited-register early)

This workshop is for the teacher who knows how to turn on a computer and who has a cursory knowledge of MS Office and PowerPoint. We will work on designing a PowerPoint presentation for use in your classroom class using tools to insert graphics, modify pages, transition from slide to slide, and animate text. We will also take some of the existing PowerPoint presentations on the curriculum CD and modify and localize them for your own program. Each participant should have a 1 gig USB portable (thumb) drive so they can take their work home with them at the end of the workshop. Utilizing Technology – Advanced (computer lab space is limited-register early)

This advanced workshop is for the teacher who isn't afraid of wrestling with a new program or two and not intimidated by a computer. If you speak "YouTube" and are ready to go behind the "pretty face" of most software to get to the information that you need to beef up your curriculum, this is your workshop! Suggestions will be given for how to build and organize support material to help you take the next step in providing support for your Driver Education program. A working knowledge of PowerPoint and Word in addition to web browser software is required to enroll in this workshop. A database system such as Excel is also recommended but not required for participation in the workshop. Each participant should have a 1 gig USB portable (thumb) drive so they can take their work home with them at the end of the workshop.
