

Outdoor Sculptures on Campus

Installed in: Winter 2005.

Location: Behind Campbell Hall.

The red arch sculpture behind Campbell Hall was constructed in the Beginning 3-D Design class during the winter term of 2005. It was an end of the year class project in which each student had to construct an outdoor installation that utilized color. The work was then displayed by the student living buildings for two weeks. The red sculpture was brought back to Campbell Hall after the exhibition and installed there.

This sculpture is constructed of plywood, which had been cut into arches and then connected by circular plywood disks that were then painted red.

The student artist, Will Drury, graduated last spring and is currently working as a graphic designer.

However, it is not a permanent sculpture and will most likely be removed before the next year is over.
