

## Finding a Book Using Subject Terms

**Step 1: Go to the Hamersly Library Website [www.wou.edu/library](http://www.wou.edu/library)**

**Step 2: Click on the WOU-Only search link**



This will search for books and ebooks related to your search terms at Western Oregon University only.

**Step 3: Click on the Subject tab at the top of the search box**



Subject searching uses the catalogs defined subjects to bring back results that are more relevant to your search.

**Step 4: Enter in your search terms and click Submit**



## Step 5: Select a subject term from the list provided



Note: Before you click on the title of a book, you can get information about the book including whether the book is an ebook or print edition (if print, where it is located in the library and if it is available for checkout).

You will be able to click on the link to the ebook after you click on the title.







## Step 8: Search Summit with Subject terms from WOU Catalog
