Guide to using the K-12 Curriculum Collection

Organization of the Collection

SAT (State Adopted Texts) For in library use only—may not be checked out.

SAT contains instructional materials found on the Oregon Department of Education approved adoption lists. Hamersly Library is the official viewing site for the ODE adopted materials. Instructional materials includes approved materials in seven subject areas that are organized by LC call numbers. In each subject area the materials are organized by publisher sets and sorted by grade level. In addition to student texts and teacher's editions sets often include a variety of supplemental materials. Some sets are not complete at this time.

English/ Language Arts/ English as a Second Language (adoption year 2006)

Health and Physical Education (adoption year 2007)

Mathematics (adoption year 2008 for K-8 and 2009 for 9-12)

Science (adoption year 2009)

World Languages (adoption year 2010)

Social Sciences (adoption year 2011)

The Arts (adoption year 2012)

Curriculum Materials May be checked out for one week-- plus one renewal.

A variety of instructional materials that are organized by LC call numbers –many items were previously in SAT, and the subjects roughly parallel those in SAT.

The oversized, big picture books are standing on a separate shelf and include both SAT and Curriculum materials. The SAT items are clearly marked with "In Library Use"

Juvenile Nonfiction & Fiction Regular checkout period of three weeks.

These collections include a representative selection of recent and older juvenile nonfiction titles, fiction titles, and picture books covering a broad range of subjects with an emphasis on notable and award-winning books.

Library Catalog

Searches in the library catalog can be limited to the curriculum collection which includes the four categories listed above: At the "Search Entire Collection" pull down menu just after the search box, select "K-12 curriculum materials" (Locations include State Textbooks Floor 2 for SATs; K-12 Curriculum Floor 2 for Curriculum; and Juvenile Floor 2 for Juvenile fiction and nonfiction)
