



Study Abroad in China: CH401
Applications of Traditional Chinese Medicine
Summer of 2012
Beijing-Huaihua-Zhangjiajie
(July 31st—August 23rd)



Program Overview:

- Earn 3 credits of upper division chemistry credit learning about the principles of Traditional Chinese Medicine (TCM)
- Visit Beijing and learn about Chinese culture and history (Forbidden City; Great Wall; Temple of Heaven; Visit a Hutong Neighborhood)
- Travel to Huaihua to attend an 8-day short course on Traditional Chinese Medicine at the Zhongfang International Red Cross Hospital (Learn basic concepts and experience demonstrations of acupuncture, tui na, cupping, moxibustion, and traditional herbal treatments)
- Attend a 4-day workshop on ancient Chinese energy work including, tai chi chuan and qigong at the beautiful Zhangjiajie National Forest Park (*where Avatar was filmed!*)

Prerequisites:

One of the following:
 CH106, CH221, BI102,
 BI211 or consent of
 instructor. PE145 is
 highly recommended.



Expenses and Requirements:

Program Cost - \$5,563. Cost includes: tuition, airfare, train tickets , all lodging expenses, some meal expenses, site-seeing in Beijing, tuition at the TCM hospital, and symposium expenses for the Tai Chi Chuan/Qigong workshop. Does not include personal expenses.

Interested participants must:

- Complete an application form by March 1st, 2012.
- Complete a student interview and pay a \$350 non-refundable deposit by check to CISAbroad by March 9th, 2012
- Attend orientation meetings during the Spring Term of 2012
- Remit payment for the trip balance by June 8th, 2012
- Upon return, students will be required to complete a 1 credit capstone project that includes evaluating a specific practice of TCM.
