

Tips for a Successful Visit to WOU

- ❖ The Office of Admissions is responsible for coordinating campus visits.

Campus Tours

- ❖ **Campus tours** are offered weekdays at 10:00 a.m., 1:30 p.m. and 2:30 p.m.
 - The 10:00 a.m. tour is 60 minutes in length and it does not include a tour of the residence halls.
 - Our afternoon tours are 90 minutes in length and include a tour of the residence halls.
- Saturday tours are only offered during our Preview Day programs.

- ❖ The Office of Admissions offers a 1:30 p.m. tour during the winter, spring and summer breaks.
 - This tour is 90 minutes long and includes a tour of the residence halls.
- ❖ We encourage visitors participating in a campus tour to wear comfortable shoes. A jacket and umbrella are advised during the winter months.
- ❖ Please plan to arrive at the WOU Office of Admissions 15 minutes prior to your first appointment or visit activity to allow time for securing a parking permit.

Scheduling Appointments

- ❖ Admissions Counselors are available by appointment to discuss admission requirements, basic financial aid/scholarship information, and university housing options.
 - Students are strongly encouraged to schedule an appointment with an Admissions Counselor prior to their campus visit.

Scheduling Appointments Contd.

- ❖ If you wish to meet with a Professor, sit in on a class, or meet with another representative on campus please submit your request to the Campus Visitation Coordinator two weeks prior to your preferred visit date.
 - Last minute requests **cannot** be accommodated. Faculty & Staff representatives require appropriate notification in scheduling appointments.
 - **Please note** that Professors and other representatives are typically available on a limited basis during the winter, spring, and summer breaks.

Parking

- ❖ The Parking Services Department strictly enforces WOU's parking policies.
 - A visitor parking pass is **required** for university operated parking lots.
 - Visitors who fail to secure a visitor parking pass from the Office of Admissions will be cited accordingly.
 - Visitor parking passes are also available at our Campus Public Safety Department, which is located on Stadium Drive.
 - Please note: Visitors who park in the "Future WOU Student" parking space still need to secure a parking permit from the Office of Admissions.
 - Please contact the Office of Admissions if you have any questions regarding visitor parking.

- ❖ Campus visitors are advised to park in Lot D, which is located on Jackson Street. The Office of Admissions is located in the Academic Programs and Support Center (APSC) Building. Directions to campus, a campus map, and local lodging options are available at: www.wou.edu/lodging.

Visit Confirmation

- ❖ Students will receive confirmation of their WOU campus visit via e-mail or letter. If you do not receive a confirmation, please contact our Campus Visitation Coordinator (visitcor@wou.edu) or the Office of Admissions prior to your visit.

- ❖ **Late arrivals:** As a courtesy to our student tour guides and other campus visitors, the Office of Admissions will not delay a campus tour for late arriving visitors. Please contact the Office of Admissions if you are experiencing a delayed arrival for your campus visit.

- ❖ **Cancelling Appointments:** If you are unable to visit campus as planned please contact the Office of Admissions so that we can notify representatives that you planned to meet with.
