## VOYAGER AWARD INFORMATION 2009-2010

### A. PURPOSE

To honor and support Oregon members of the National Guard and Reserves who have been deployed in a combat zone since September 11, 2001.

### B. BENEFITS TO SOLDIERS

With this program, qualifying members of the National Guard and Reserves may receive funds to cover the cost of actual tuition and fees (mandatory enrollment costs). The Voyager funds will cover tuition and fees not covered by National Guard tuition assistance benefits. Students who are eligible to receive such benefits are responsible for securing the tuition assistance benefit (currently \$4,500 per fiscal year) from the National Guard. For some students, the amount of tuition assistance received from the National Guard will cover all tuition and fees at WOU; in such cases, no Voyager funds will be awarded. For reservists (Navy and Marine) who do not receive tuition benefits, the Voyager funds will cover all mandatory tuition and fees up to 18 credits per term.

### C. ELIGIBILITY

1. Must be a member of National Guard or Reserves and must have been called to active duty and served in a combat zone since September 11, 2001.
2. Must be an Oregon resident as defined by OAR 580-010-0030 through 580-010-0045.
3. Must have a valid, complete FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) and financial aid file each year.
4. Must be fully admitted to WOU.
5. Must be seeking an initial bachelor's degree only.
6. Must be a full-time student. Half-time student tuition benefits from the National Guard Tuition Assistance program cover the entire cost of half-time enrollment.
7. The duration of the award will be a maximum of four years. A maximum credit limit is set at fifteen credits above the minimum number of credits required to complete the chosen degree. Students must re-apply for the award each year, and will be awarded based on eligibility and available funding. Specific award amounts will be determined based on the number of credits taken and the amount received (if any) of National Guard tuition assistance.
8. Must maintain satisfactory academic progress for continued eligibility.
9. Benefits are not transferable to a spouse or other family member of the soldier.

### D. APPLICATION

To apply, complete the application on the reverse side.

### E. VOYAGER AWARD AMOUNT

For eligible students, the amount of the award will initially be estimated at 12 credits. You may apply the funds, along with any other financial aid, during fee payment.

*A status check will be completed after the fourth week of the term to determine how many credits for which you are still registered. If you are registered for more than 12 credits, your award will be adjusted and you may be reimbursed for the additional credits. If, however, after the fourth week of the term, you are registered for less than 12 credits, your award will be adjusted and you will be billed back for any funds for which you are no longer eligible. Please check the Schedule of Classes for important dates such as the last day to pay fees, the last day to drop a course, etc.*
