



Dual Enrollment Checklist for Financial Aid

Western Oregon University (WOU) and Chemeketa Community College (CCC) have signed a consortium agreement under which students may concurrently enroll at both institutions and have their combined credit loads serve as a basis for establishing financial aid eligibility.

To allow for timely processing your request to participate in this program, a DUAL ENROLLMENT DEADLINE is set THREE weeks prior to the beginning of the term. In most instances, WOU will be considered the Home Institution for financial aid purposes. Please complete and submit the attached paperwork to be considered as part of the Dual Enrollment Program. The Dual Enrollment Program is for first Bachelor Degree seeking students only.

You must be fully admitted to WOU to be eligible for this program. Admissions applications are available on-line at www.wou.edu/admissions. To opt-out of the Dual Enrollment Program, please give written request to the WOU Financial Aid Office.

Student's (your) responsibilities

If you would like to receive financial aid at Western Oregon University you need to:

- Apply for federal and state financial aid using the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) available on-line at www.fafsa.ed.gov.
- Turn in any additional documents requested by the Financial Aid Office.
- Submit your signed financial aid award letter.
- Submit your signed loan promissory notes if necessary: Federal Direct Stafford _____, Federal Perkins _____, Federal PLUS _____. Master Promissory Notes can be completed at www.dlenote.ed.gov.
- Complete entrance loan counseling with the Financial Aid Office. This must be done prior to receiving any loans. Loan counseling can be completed at www.dl.ed.gov.

If you would like the WOU Financial Aid Office to consider you as a dual enrolled student you need to:

- Submit a Dual Enrollment Application available at the WOU Financial Aid Office.
- Submit Student Declaration of Concurrent Enrollment form.
- Register for classes at Chemeketa Community College.
- Register for classes at Western Oregon University (minimum 6 credits).
- Pay all outstanding fees at Chemeketa Community College.

Once you have completed the necessary paperwork, notice will be sent to your WOU email account stating that you have been enrolled as a dual-enrolled student with Chemeketa Community College.

Please note that it is your responsibility to pay your fees at Chemeketa Community College. Financial aid will not be applied to your bill at Chemeketa Community College. In some instances, students will need to use their own resources to pay outstanding fees. Except in rare instances, financial aid will be disbursed from WOU exclusively.

**Student Declaration of Concurrent Enrollment for Financial Aid Eligibility
Western Oregon University/Chemeketa Community College**

Western Oregon University (WOU) and Chemeketa Community College (CCC) have signed a consortium agreement under which students may concurrently enroll at both institutions and have their combined credit loads serve as a basis for establishing financial aid eligibility. Under this agreement, student financial aid eligibility will be processed and awarded by the "home" institution (determined by the student's immediate degree objective) using shared information from the "host" institution (the college where the student is concurrently enrolled while attending his/her "home" institution. WOU must be the "home" institution if you have an associate's degree or you want to receive aid for 300 level or higher courses.

The community college releases only very limited directory information regarding students such as enrollment status, dates of enrollment, degree or certificate, program of study, athletic statistic, or honors awarded. If you do not want any person outside the college, including prospective employers, to know any of these, you must file a Request for Non-Disclosure of Student Information Form with Chemeketa Community College.

Students may receive financial aid from only one school during any given term of enrollment. Your credit hours for registration at WOU and Chemeketa Community College will be combined each term to determine your enrollment level for financial aid ability. Community colleges exclude 300-400 level courses when determining level of enrollment. Credit hours must apply to your current degree objective to be included in your enrollment for aid purposes.

Students should list all institutions at which they will enroll on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
