

Describe an activity suitable for the Math and Science Night at an elementary school. It is ok to look up ideas on the web.

**Guidelines:**

1. The activity should be fun, interesting, have mathematical content and be accessible to children ages K-5. It is OK, to have different levels of the activity for different ages (e.g. one version for K-2, and another for 3-5).
2. The activity should be able to be done individually, i.e., the kids should be able to come up to your table and do the activity with only minimal instruction from you as you will have many kids at the table arriving at different times.
3. We have budget to buy some materials, but not a lot of expensive stuff. (e.g. we could provide the materials to make some sort of goopy stuff that each kid could take a little of home).
4. It's ok to be a little messy, but not too messy. Don't suggest anything dangerous.
