**PROGRAM INFORMATION:**

The Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) program at Linfield College – Portland is a transfer program with students finishing two years of pre-requisites (90 credit hours) before entering into the program. Students will then spend 2 years in the program to finish up their BSN. Over the last several years, approximately 600 – 800 students have applied annually for the program with approximately 80 – 90 transfer students accepted each year. The recent average GPA of students entering into the program has been ~ 3.6 on a 4.0 GPA scale. Once accepted into the program, students either begin in the fall or spring of the following academic year depending on space availability. The cost of tuition for attending the nursing program at Linfield College – Portland is approximately \$30,000 per year. Linfield does have scholarships available to entering students to help defray the cost of the program.
