PROGRAM INFORMATION:

The Bachelor of Science - Nursing emphasis Program at Oregon Health Sciences University is a transfer program with students finishing a minimum of one year of pre-requisites (45 credit hours) before entering into the program. Students will then spend 3 years in the program to complete their nursing degree. Over the last several years, approximately 800 students have applied annually for the program with approximately 175 students accepted each year. The recent average GPA of students entering into the program has been ~ 3.7 on a 4.0 GPA scale. Students apply to one of five branch campuses: Portland (OHSU), Monmouth (WOU) Klamath Falls (OIT), Ashland (SOU), or La Grande (EOU) with classes beginning in the fall term of the application year. The cost of tuition for attending the nursing program at OHSU is approximately \$15,000 per year (dependent on campus attended). OHSU does have scholarships available to entering students to help defray the cost of the program.

APPLYING TO THE PROGRAM:

Listed below are the materials to be included for a complete application file:*

- *Completed application form* (on-line only – paper applications not accepted)
- *Official college transcripts* (from each college / university attended)
- *\$120.00 non-refundable application fee* (make check payable to OHSU)
- *Proctored essay* (must be completed before application deadline with appropriate individual)
- *Completed scholarship application* (if applicable – see website for application)

Deadline: February 16, 2010 (students may not apply earlier than October 1, 2009)

* Individuals applying to the OHSU branch campuses at Eastern Oregon University (EOU), Southern Oregon University (SOU), Western Oregon University (WOU), or Oregon Institute of Technology (OIT) use the same on-line application process as those applying to the main OHSU Portland campus.

ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS FOR APPLICATION:

- 1) Completion of pre-requisites coursework (see back of sheet for pre-requisite coursework).
- 2) A minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 based on all transferable credits with a “C” grade or better earned in all lower division prerequisites.

Competencies: (Must be met to enter into OHSU program)

Mathematics:

Competency for math 095 or above must be demonstrated prior to application to the nursing program. Competency may be demonstrated by a math placement test or by successful completion of Math 095 or higher. Note: Math 095 credits are not applicable to credits for the Bachelor's degree; however, math courses that are 100 or higher may be included in the credits that are applied to the prerequisites and to the degree. **IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED THAT STUDENTS COMPLETE MATH 111 – COLLEGE ALGEBRA.**

Basic Computer Literacy:

College credit work or life experiences can meet this competency. **IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED THAT STUDENTS COMPLETE COMPUTER SCIENCE 121 – COMPUTER APPLICATIONS.**

Foreign Language Proficiency Requirement:

Language proficiency is a baccalaureate graduation requirement that can be met by 1) two years of high school language, 2) two quarters of college level language, or 3) a language proficiency examination. American Sign Language is an accepted language to meet this requirement.
